1. Introduction to the 2025 HIPAA Regulations

Background and Motivation Behind the Updates

1. The Seven New HIPAA Rules for 2025

Rule 1: Expanded Patient Rights for Access to Health Information

- Patients now have enhanced rights to access their health information, including the ability to inspect and photograph their medical records in person.
- The maximum response time for fulfilling access requests has been reduced from 30 days to 15 days, promoting faster, more patient-centric access.

Rule 2: Updates to the Breach Notification Rule

- The timeframe for notifying affected individuals and the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) of data breaches involving PHI has been reduced.
- This change aims for prompt action and greater transparency when data breaches occur.

o Rule 3: Enhanced Reproductive Healthcare Privacy Protections

- New protections broaden the definition of reproductive health care to include contraception, fertility treatment, miscarriage care, and terminations.
- These protections ensure sensitive reproductive health information is not used in out-of-state legal proceedings.
- Unauthorized disclosures of reproductive healthcare data will be treated as notifiable breaches under HIPAA.

Rule 4: Enhanced Security Risk Assessment Requirements

 Covered entities and business associates must conduct more frequent and comprehensive security risk assessments. ■ This proactive approach ensures vulnerabilities are identified and appropriate steps are taken to protect PHI against emerging threats.

Rule 5: Strengthened Data Encryption Standards

- Emphasizes more robust encryption for both data at rest and in transit to address growing cyber threats in healthcare.
- Ensures stronger protection of sensitive healthcare data from unauthorized access.
- Requires de-identification of data wherever possible to minimize risks.

Rule 6: Guidance on Third-Party Website Tracking

- Covered entities must assess the risks associated with thirdparty tracking tools (e.g., cookies, pixels) used on healthcare websites.
- Introduces requirements to update privacy policies, implement consent management tools, and ensure that shared PHI complies with new standards to prevent unauthorized disclosures.

Rule 7: Regulations on Al and Machine Learning

- New guidelines regulate how Al and machine learning technologies handle PHI.
- Requires safeguards to ensure that AI usage does not compromise patient privacy and confidentiality.
- Al systems must adhere to specific limitations, such as not accessing PHI directly without appropriate de-identification and control measures.
